


Innovative Approach in Adult Education

Inspired by the Thousand and One Nights Tales, E-SHAHRAZAD project aims to bridge the gap between the young and the adult generation, from the past to the future, with stories that are the best means of learning in every era. Digital Storytelling will be used as a method in intergenerational learning. Within the 24 months (March 2021 to February 2023), the project will continue with the specific target group, which are adults over 55 years old and young people aged 18-25.

- Basic skills and ICT skills development, which is the most important skill of today and during and after COVID-19 period of daily life.
- Digital skills, communicating, learning, expressing experience, understanding narrative, shaping stories and using media.
- Development of associated skills (ICT, creative writing, video production, presentation skills, mentoring skills).
- Capacity building; providing training materials for both younger and older people, materials for intergenerational learning courses.

Our Project Focuses On Three Main Needs In:

Digital literacy and skills; while rapid change, virtual world, technological advances are defined as an important requirement in social and economic

life, Covid-19 is no longer a need and has become a necessity. Numerousscientific studies and EU Adult Education reports support this.

The Covid-19 process is both a pandemic and isolation process, and a sociological process that requires to be evaluated with a



social transformation and new arguments. The definition of the risk group of adults above 55+ and isolation made the feeling of loneliness established. Intergenerational learning will strengthen social ties and provide a link with the past for the future.

Especially, the experiences / fictional stories that adults over the age of 55 will tell are a very important method for intergenerational learning, while being a record for oral history.

Activities



Four intellectual outputs will be prepared within the scope of E-SHAHRAZAD. These are:

- Development Methodology to Digital Storytelling in Intergenerational Learning
- Preparation of the Guide and Toolkits for Digital Storytelling in Intergenerational Dimension for Adult Education
- Establishment of Digital Storytelling HUB (E-Shrazad Hub)
- Compendium of Digital Stories and International Digital Storytelling Festival

In England and Italy, a 5-day training program will be organized for a total of 20 trainers working in adult education. Trainers participating in these training will organize 6 workshops in their countries with adults over 55 and young people between the ages of 18-25. At the end of the pilot programs, each country will prepare Digital Stories.







